IMS Racing Yachts



Two new DIAB cored IMS racing yachts, Tau and Azur de Puig, have made their debuts in 2004 competing successfully in a variety of races in Spain and Europe. The former was designed by Rolf Vrolijk and built by Técnica y Regatas in Spain, the yard that will be building the Spanish challenger for the America's Cup.

Tau has had a very successful season, winning the Trofeo Freixenet, the Trofeo Conde Godó and, most notably, the European IMS Championships. Owned by Javier and Antonio Banderas, the 57 ft. LOA Tau uses Klegecell SR for the hull and deck and Divinycell HPS for the internal structure.

The smaller Azur de Puig (49 ft. LOA) was designed by Botín & Carkeek and also uses Divinycell HPS. Although flying the Spanish flag, Azur de Puig was built at Green Marine in Lymington, UK.
